Getting Relationships Right (Feb 12-March 19)

SERIES OVERVIEW: Throughout this series, we are deep diving into how we can have strong, healthy, and thriving relationships with God and with others. The first half of this series is focused on our relationship with God, others, and our family. The second half of this series is going to zero in on how to navigate romantic relationships wisely. To illustrate the key principles and practices we need to get our relationships right, we will be examining some of the best (and worst) examples from the Old Testament so that, when everything is said and done, our students will have the biblical understanding and the practical skills to live rightly with God and with others.

MAIN IDEA: The greatest calling of our lives is to <u>love God</u> with all our heart, soul, mind, and strength, and to <u>love others</u> the same way Jesus does.

Week 1: Loving God

MAIN IDEA: The <u>most important</u> relationship to get right is your relationship with <u>God</u>.

TEACHING TEXT: 2 God said, "Take your son, your only son, whom you love—Isaac —and go to the region of Moriah. Sacrifice him there as a burnt offering on a mountain I will show you." Genesis 22:2 NIV

WHAT DO WE WANT STUDENTS TO KNOW? The most important thing we can do in our lives is love God with all that we are. Everything else flows from that. And, one of the best examples of someone who loved God with all their heart, soul, mind, and strength is Abraham. A guy who lived by faith. Faith is trust, based on evidence, that leads to obedience. We show our love for God the same way, by trusting what He says, based on the evidence of what He's done, and responding with obedience to His commands.

WHAT DO WE WANT STUDENTS TO FEEL? Confident that God is faithful. Inspired to live by faith. Hopeful that growing in their love for God will strengthen the other relationships in their lives.

WHAT DO WE WANT STUDENTS TO DO? Demonstrate their love for God by choosing to do everything God asks them to do.

Week 2: Loving Others

MAIN IDEA: Love is a choice to <u>sacrifice</u> ourselves for the good of <u>others</u>.

TEACHING TEXT: 15 The king of Egypt said... 16 "When you are helping the Hebrew women during childbirth on the delivery stool, if you see that the baby is a boy, kill him..." 17 The midwives, however, feared God and did not do what the king of Egypt had told them to do; they let the boys live. Exodus 1:15-17 NIV

WHAT DO WE WANT STUDENTS TO KNOW? Loving others is about so much more than strong feelings or positive thoughts. It's a decision we make to sacrifice ourselves to serve them. Our love for others is revealed most clearly by our actions. The good news? God went first. He sacrificed Himself on the cross to rescue us from sin, repair our relationship with Him, and restore our purpose. Because we have received His love, we can now show it to others.

WHAT DO WE WANT STUDENTS TO FEEL? Grateful that God loved us first. Challenged to sacrifice their own wants and desires to help others. Confident that love is the thing that will strengthen their relationships with others.

MAIN IDEA: Honoring your family means <u>loving</u> them regardless of how they treat <u>you</u>.

TEACHING TEXT: 19 But Joseph said to them, "Don't be afraid. Am I in the place of God? 20 You intended to harm me, but God intended it for good to accomplish what is now being done, the saving of many lives. 21 ... And he reassured them and spoke kindly to them. Genesis 50:19-21 NIV

WHAT DO WE WANT STUDENTS TO KNOW? Loving your family and treating them well can be really difficult. Especially when they don't do the same for you. But, that doesn't change the fact that God has commanded us to honor our parents and love our neighbors the way we would want to be loved (and your siblings do count as neighbors).

WHAT DO WE WANT STUDENTS TO FEEL? Hopeful that they can strengthen their relationships at home by doing their part to love and honor their parents and siblings. Inspired to bring their best to these relationships even when it gets difficult.
